Wapiti Pasture is easy to establish and has very deep roots that make it drought tolerant. This mix works well in wet pastures and dry sites alike as it is a combination of Facultative Wetland (FACW) species and Faculative Upland (FACU) species. Many of the species are recommended by the Department of Fish and Wildlife for restoration of native forage areas.
